EARLY NH FOOD DEMONSTRATIONS: SUNDAY, JUNE 12 AT 12 PM-3 PM

We will be preparing foods of early times & sharing info on what life was like in the 1800-1900s. New Englanders grew wheat for flour & baked bread, corn for cornmeal mush, root vegetables such as potatoes & turnips, baked beans, hunted wild game & raised farm animals for milk & meat.

Displays on the fiber arts, textiles, quilted fabrics, weaved baskets, wall hangings, needlework stitching, beads, yarns & hooked rugs. Demonstrations & artwork.

EARLY FARM TOOLS: SUNDAY, AUG 14 FROM 12 PM-3 PM

Displays of tools used on the farm in the 1800s & 1900s. Farmers cultivated their land with crude wooden plows or hand held hoes, sowed seeds by hand & used oxen, mules & draft horses for power.

September


HISTORY DAY OPEN HOUSE: SUNDAY, SEPT 11 FROM 12 PM-3 PM
