Harry Prouty, a lifelong logger, will share many of the tools used by old time loggers & show how they used them. He will show a movie of old time loggers back about 80-90 years ago. He tells stories from old time loggers & may even do a few tunes on his harmonica! Lumbering has played a major part in our town's history. NH forests gave rise to a logging industry that supported the state through much of its early development. Trees have been harvested in NH since early settlers began to clear land for farming.
