Chairman England opened the meeting at 6:10pm.

Checks/Applications/Signatures

- **Payroll and accounts payable** were signed.
- February bank reconciliations were signed.
- Lyn made a motion to approve a purchase order for the Police Department for an armored vest for the chief in the amount of \$638. Motion was seconded by Jessica. Motion passed 3-0.

Old Business:

A check was received from Jared King logging for the \$5,000 road bond. The check will be held until the logging operation is complete. If any road repairs are needed the check will be deposited.

A taxpayer request for tax deferral and abatement will be reviewed at the next meeting.

New Business:

Property owners at 55 Sheldon Road have an error in acreage on their tax assessment. They are being assessed for 7 additional acres since 2016. An abatement check will be prepared for the next meeting.

90 day performance evaluations have been received for the new highway department employees.

Selectmen

- The Board received a letter from Archie Auger regarding the school default budget. In his opinion hundreds of thousands of dollars are included in the default budget that legally should not be in it. All of the Selectmen agree with his opinion. His recommendation is to vote against the operating budget of the school and once the default budget comes into play, it can be contested

At 6:25 pm Lyn made a motion to go into non public session per

RSA 91-A:3, II (a) The dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a public meeting, and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted.

Motion was seconded by Jim. Lyn - yes, Jim - yes, Jessica - yes. Motion passed and non public session began.

At 6:40 the board came out of non public session. No decisions were made and no votes taken.
