Mark Zaccaria deferred the review of the June 25 meeting minutes to the next meeting.

At 7:06pm opened the continued public hearing on the Community Improvement Plan (CIP). Jim Phelps asked if the board chairs had turned in their mileage and usage. Chief Kelby said that he turned it into the Board of Selectmen Administrator, Jeremy Cornell said that he did not turn them in. Jim suggested continuing the meeting to August to have that information in front of us for approval. Gary asked if the guests present were happy with the draft CIP as written, since we had edited it quite a bit from last year's version. Jess answered yes, she was happy. Jess asked if the compacter should be kept on the CIP, Mark thought that this could go either way. Jess also mentioned that there was an emergency bridge closure that just happened and that the amount allocated for the Bridge reserve would likely need to increase. Ruby asked why there are little amounts allocated for each line item, instead of a bigger cost in less years. Anna answered that this was what was requested by the Budget Committee members and Selectboard members present at the first public hearing. Jim Phelps made a motion to recess the public hearing to the meeting on August 13th, Ruby Hill seconded. **Motion passed unanimously.**
