The Danbury Planning Board met on Tuesday June 11th, 2024 in accordance with the schedule adopted and posted. John Taylor called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and welcomed everyone present. John asked if anyone had a conflict of interest and hearing none proceeded with the meeting.

John Taylor appointed Anna Offen to be a voting member of the Board.

At 7:06pm John Taylor opened the public hearing on the Capital Improvements Plan (CIP). Jim Phelps asked if the Board was still comfortable with the definition of capital item, worth at least \$5,000 and had a lifespan of 6 years. This was previously defined by the Planning Board. Jim asked if it would be helpful to have an inventory of mileage and/or hours of usage on an annual basis. Department heads will get the usage information to the Planning Board on an annual basis to add to the report. A member of the public asked if it would be better to have smaller amounts added in each year, rather than bigger amounts in less years. Jessica Hatch stated that it would be much more helpful to the Board of Selectmen to have the amounts listed each year, in this manner. The Planning Board then went through each item on the CIP, line by line and with input from those present, updated each item. Anna Offen made a motion to continue the public hearing to July 9th, 2024, Mark Zaccaria seconded. **Motion passed unanimously**.

The Board reviewed the meeting minutes from May 28th, 2024. Mark Zaccaria made a motion to approve the minutes as written, Anna Offen seconded. **Motion passed unanimously.**

The board discussed a question that was raised regarding a citizen's helicopter pad. It was determined the OAP, State Transportation Commissioner and/or the town attorney should be contacted regarding this.
