General Provisions:

An excavation permit shall be obtained from the Town of Danbury's Board of Selectmen prior to disturbing, excavating, or opening the ground or pavement in any street or highway with the Town of Danbury's public right-of-way, or on Town property.

All work permitted under this agreement shall be conducted at all times in a manner that maintains safety and minimizes inconvenience to the traveling public.

All trees, fences, shrubbery, etc. shall be protected. No trees or shrubs shall be cut or trimmed within the town right-of-way without specific authorization. All disturbed areas of the roadway shall be restored to an improved condition.

Any future distortion due to settlement or other causes attributable to installation or operation of this encroachment shall be corrected as required.

All conduits shall be placed in accordance with the National Electrical Safety Code in effect at the time this permit is granted, at a minimum of 4 feet deep, and with a minimum of schedule 80 pipe. Proper safety ribbon should be installed.

The contractor's work shall be limited to Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 am to 4:00 pm.

The Danbury Road Agent shall be notified prior to the work being done.
