The Board reviewed the meeting minutes from March 19th, 2024. JP made a motion to approve the minutes as amended, MZ seconded. **Motion passed unanimously.** **Amendment to include changing "State" to "County Registry of Deeds" on page 2, paragraph 8.*

John Taylor discussed with the board his research that was done on the solar installations. He received information from LRPC that included copies of other town's ordinances with examples on how solar installations were included. He will email the copies to the Board for review. More discussion will be held regarding this at future meetings.

John also relayed some information from the LRPC meeting regarding projects that the Town of Danbury had on the 10 year plan for the LRPC. The LRPC receives grant money from the State and then allocates funds to different towns for projects that are on the list. We will review this list further at our CIP meeting.

Anna Offen brought to the board's attention that bill HB 1291 has passed the House. This bill is in regards to Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU). The bill still needs to go to the Senate, but is something that the Board will want to keep an eye on, as it aims to increase the allowed ADU from 1 to 2 per lot.
