The Board reviewed the meeting minutes from February 13th 2024. Ruby Hill made a motion to approve the minutes, Mark Zaccaria seconded. **Motion passed unanimously.**

The Board discussed the decision by the Selectboard to sign the approval for the subdivision for 3J Farms. A timeline was reviewed on when attorneys were notified, why the decision was made, etc. The Selectboard met with the attorney in non-public session so they were not able to disclose what was said in that meeting, however they did state that they were advised to the sign the plan by their attorney. It was discovered after they had signed the mylars that the Marchands would be moving forward with their appeal. The Planning Board has submitted their required response to the Housing Board of Appeals. It is unknown what will happen with the Marchands appeal, so the Boards will need to wait for that to finish before taking any next steps. Both the Planning Board and the Board of Selectmen expressed their frustration with the situation and discussed options to alleviate the confusion and frustration of the process moving forward.
