John Taylor appointed Jim Phelps to be a voting member.

The board reviewed the meeting minutes from February 14th, 2023. Ruby Hill made a motion to approve the minute, Mark Zaccaria seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Phil Hastings came before the board to discuss a proposed subdivision for Ragged Mountain and an update to the Ragged Mountain Master Plan. After discussion with Phil, Attorney Mike Donovan and the board, it was determined that the Master Plan would need to be updated before going forward with any subdivision.

The board discussed the Mast Plan updates and what they would like to see from Ragged. Phil is envisioning a re-draft of the plan with updates to what has been done, what they would like to do and what is off the table. The Board discussed whether this would be considered a Development of Regional Impact (DRI) and if so will need to be noticed as such. Jim Phelps moved that the update is considered a DRI, Ruby Hill seconded. **Motion passed unanimously**.

Anna Offen made a motion that the subdivision application for Forest Knolls is considered incomplete until the Master Plan revisions have been presented, Jim Phelps seconded. **Motion passed unanimously.**

Ruby Hill made a motion to continue the public hearing on the Master Plan updates to April 25th, 2023, Jim Phelps seconded. **Motion passed unanimously and hearing was continued**.
